- For: 15 people for Beginner, 12 people for Elementary, and 12 people for Intermediate
- Qualification
 - Must be a foreigner living in Suwon, who can attend the class until the end of the course
 - ※ **Preferred**
 - Those who can spend time with a Korean Buddy for supplementary study and conversational practice
 - Those who are working in Suwon
- Class levels: Beginner, Elementary, Intermediate
 - ※ **Courses are free of charge, but students should buy textbooks themselves**
